



**Theme:** Water Heroes: Make Every Drop Count

**Target Group:** Years 3 – 6 (ages 8-12)

### Learning Objectives

- Deepen understanding of water as a vital resource.
  - Reflect on environmental responsibility and personal action.
  - Develop persuasive messages through slogan and poster design.
  - Collaborate and think critically about sustainability.

### Discussion Prompts

Use these questions to guide classroom discussion and build ideas for student posters.

- What is a Hero? What does being a Water Hero mean to you?
  - How do we use water every day, and how can we reduce waste?
  - What happens if we don't take care of our water sources?
  - How can we encourage others to become Water Heroes?
  - How can art be used to raise awareness about important environmental issues?

### Activity 1: Brainstorming and Planning (Group Brainstorming or Note-Taking Space)

Encourage students to brainstorm ideas about water conservation.

They can work in pairs or groups to:

- list how water is used in daily life
  - identify actions that waste water and solutions to reduce use
  - define what a Water Hero looks like
  - choose a message or slogan that others can learn from.

### Activity 2: Slogan and Message Creation

Students create a slogan or water-saving message to include on their poster. Challenge them to make it catchy and meaningful!

### Activity 3: Poster Sketch

Students use the mind map to help note down key areas for them to focus on to create their poster. Once complete, using the box provided, students sketch a draft of their poster idea.

Remind them to include:

- a clear message or slogan
- images of their Water Hero or water-saving action
- creative layout, colour, and design to grab attention.

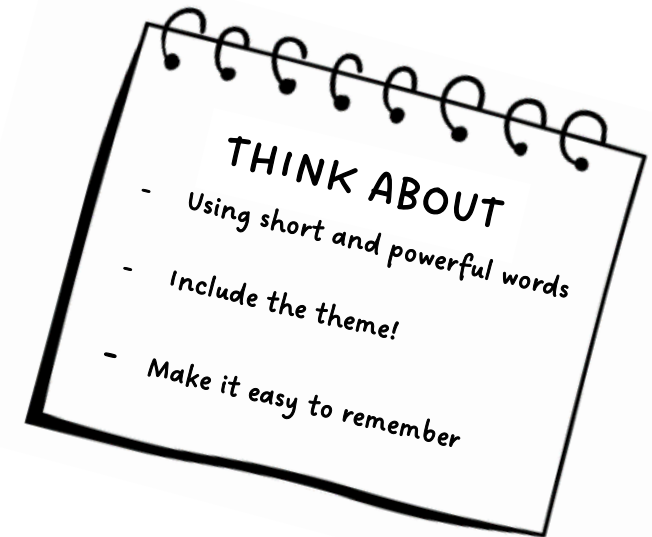


